Safety Protocols: HARC will comply with all health and safety recommendations of state and local governments. Masks are optional, social distancing (6 feet minimum) will be required when congregating and when visiting the HARC or tables. The safety and health measures are subject to change based on guidelines and conditions on the hunt day.

Directions from Houston:

Travel Interstate 45 South (Gulf Freeway) to the Galveston Causeway. Soon after crossing the Causeway, I-45 becomes Broadway (Hwy 87). Continue traveling along Broadway for approximately 4.2 miles to Seawall Blvd. Turn left and continue until it ends, turn right at Boddeker drive.

Directions from I-10 in Winnie:

From I-10 in Winnie, take the Hwy 124 (beach) exit. Take Hwy 124 to High Island. Turn right on Hwy 87. Take Hwy 87 to the Ferry. Take the Ferry across the channel to Galveston (takes about 20 minutes). Continue on Ferry road to Seawall Boulevard. Turn left and continue until it ends, turn right at Boddeker drive.

East Beach, Apffel Park 1923 Boddeker Drive. Look for the HARC signs near the pavilion parking area.



Silver Dimes hunt:

Silver dimes with some Barbers and Seated.

Dollars & Tokens hunt

Clad \$1 coins and tokens for **Canada 80% Silver Dollars**

40% silver halves & Tokens hunt

40% silver halves and tokens for **US 90% Silver Dollars**

FREE KIDS hunt

Kids 12 and under (must be accompanied by a registered hunter, or hunt worker). Clad quarters, small bags of wheat pennies, tokens for a metal detector and other prizes. All prizes are donated by HARC, First Texas, & Garrett.

Silver dimes and quarters. With dime tokens for 1 oz silver rounds/bars, donated prizes, gold coins, and metal detectors.
